7. PROCEDURES FOR OBTAINING SERVICE (continued)

7.2 Contracting for Interruptible Transportation and Storage Service:

Interruptible service under Rate Schedules IT-1 or LGS-2 shall be provided when, and to the extent that, Transporter determines that interruptible capacity is available in Transporter's existing facilities.

A party may submit to Transporter a request for interruptible service using the Transportation/Storage Service Request Form set forth at Section 25.1 of the General Terms and Conditions. Transporter will evaluate the information offered in support of the request for service to determine whether the request and the service requestor meet the requirements of this tariff. In the case of requests for service under Rate Schedule LGS-2, Transporter will also evaluate whether there is adequate capacity to fulfill the request for service and whether the request for service is compatible with the operating conditions on Transporter's system. Requests for interruptible service will be invalid and will not be considered if service is requested to commence later than six months after the Transportation Service Request Form is submitted to Transporter. The service requestor must also satisfy Transporter's creditworthiness requirement set forth in Section 7.4.

If Transporter determines that it can provide the requested service and the service requestor otherwise meets the requirements of this tariff, Transporter will tender to the service requestor for execution a Service Agreement in the form contained in this tariff. If the requestor fails to execute the Service Agreement and return it to Transporter within 20 days of the date tendered, the requestor's request for service will be deemed null and void.

7.3 Verification:

As a condition to providing service under Section 284.102 of the Commission's regulations for any Shipper under this tariff, Shipper shall provide certification including sufficient information to verify that its services qualify under said section. Prior to commencing transportation service described in Section 284.102(d)(3) of the Commission's Regulations, Transporter must receive the certification required from a local distribution company or an intrastate pipeline pursuant to Section 284.102(d)(3).

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
